Part B encourages the Chapters to plan special evenings and events within the Chapter to encourage members to participate.

Part C gives the Chapters credit for continuing with a membership program.

Part D recognizes our Chapters for the good work they do in our communities and the support they give to a variety of charities.

Assign one person from your Chapter to keep track of the points. Review the points and requirements periodically to make sure you are track to earn the award.
