This year the WGM Accomplishment Award can be achieved by earning a minimum number of points in each of the four categories. Please keep the requirements in mind when you are planning your Chapter's activities for the year.

Part A emphasizes attendance at Eastern Star events, visiting other Chapters and Masonic Youth groups and taking care of our shut-in Sisters and Brothers.

Part B encourages the Chapters to plan special evenings and events within the Chapter to encourage members to participate.

Part C gives the Chapter credit and encouragement for continuing with a membership program.

Part D recognizes our Chapters for the good work they are doing in our communities and the support they give to a variety of charities.

Assign one person from your Chapter to keep track of the points. Review the points and requirements periodically to make sure you are on track to earn the award.

The award form must:
